

SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY RELATIONS

1005.00 CITIZEN APPEAL

Rationale

The Mingo County Board of Education believes that both the school and the citizenry of the county are better served when a sincere effort is made to find constructive solutions to complaints that may arise. The intent of this policy is to provide a simple, straight forward and easily understood way for solving problems at the lowest possible level as fairly and quickly as possible.

Effective Date

This policy shall be in effect beginning with the 2011/2012 school term and thereafter.

Complaint Alleging A Violation of State Law or State/Local Board Policy

A citizen, who alleges a violation of State Law or State/Local Board Policies, shall follow the appeal procedures specified in WVBOE Policy 7211(126 CSR 188). Appropriate forms are available in the office of the Superintendent.

Employee Due Process

Nothing within this regulation shall be construed to limit any relevant due process rights of school employees relative to decisions which may adversely affect terms and conditions of employment. Any disciplinary action taken against an employee as a result of the complaint shall be pursuant to the provision in §18A-2-7 and §18A-2-8 of the West Virginia Code and the employee shall be provided all procedural due process rights contained therein.
