STUDENT ACCESSIBILITY TO THE
STUDENT RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES HANDBOOK

It shall be the policy of the Mingo County Board of Education that the contents of the Student Rights and Responsibilities Handbook be made available to students. Teachers, counselors and principals should work in a co-operative manner to assure that students are apprised of their responsibilities and rights on a general basis and/or as specific questions arise.

Elementary schools should maintain copies of the handbook in the principal's office, and library, if applicable. Elementary classroom teachers should discuss the rights and responsibilities of students on a regular basis in conjunction with other school rules. Specific concerns should be referred to the principal for further interpretation.

Secondary schools should maintain two (2) copies of the handbook in the library, the counselors office and the principal's office. Classroom teachers should discuss the rights and responsibilities of students on a regular or need basis in conjunction with other school rules. Specific concerns should be referred to the guidance counselor or principal for further interpretation.
