1120.00 Student Drivers

The Mingo County Board of Education believes students, in grades nine through twelve only, can drive private vehicles to and from school and, therefore, are subject to the rules established by this policy. This policy will govern student drivers and provide for safety measures.

OBJECTIVES

- To promote preventive vehicle safety
- To define responsibilities of the student drivers.

PROCEDURES

1. Permission to drive a private vehicle to school shall be obtained from the school principal or designee.
2. Students, granted permission to drive a private vehicle to and from respective schools, shall be issued a vehicle permit by the school principal or designee. Vehicle permits must be displayed in private vehicle windows.
3. Students, granted permission to drive a personal vehicle to and from respective schools, will complete a vehicle identification form annually, and the form will be kept on file in the school office. This form must be accompanied by the following:
 - Registration card
 - Proof of Insurance
 - Driver's License
 - Written Parental Permission
4. Students, granted permission to drive a private vehicle to and from school, shall check keys into the office upon arrival and shall not check keys out until the end of the

school day, unless written early dismissal request is made by parent or guardian.

5. Students, granted permission to drive a private vehicle to and from school, will arrive and leave school at a time designated by the principal which will NOT interfere with bus traffic.
6. If transportation is provided for curricular or extra curricular events by the school system, the student will have no option to drive a private vehicle.
7. The student(s) can lose the privilege of driving personal vehicle(s) to and from school if county rules or policies are violated.
