POLICY ON STUDY OF  
MULTI-CULTURAL EDUCATION

In order to comply with the provisions of H.B. 1050, Amended 18-5-15a, the Mingo County Board of Education shall annually provide a program, during at least one non-instructional day of the school term, for the study of multi-cultural education, for all school personnel, as delineated by State Code 18-5-15A.

Multi-cultural education is here defined as the study of the pluralistic nature of American society, evaluating its values, institutions, organizations, groups, and status positions and social roles.

The implementation of State Code 18-5-15a for professional personnel shall be met through approved county Continuing Education programs, which provide for the design and delivery of training to meet local needs.

For all service personnel State Code 18-5-15a shall be met through the development of multi-cultural programs, which accommodate the unique needs and job functions. The standards for training programs shall correspond to the Guidelines for the Preparation of the Three-Year County Continuing Education Plan.

The county Superintendent of Schools shall approve the planned programs yearly.
