

Care of the Grounds

- a. The custodian shall see that rubbish, stones, paper, dry leaves, or other foreign matter is removed.
- b. He shall cut the grass as often as necessary.
- c. He shall see that the shrubbery and trees are trimmed as often as necessary.
- d. He shall see that the earth is loosened around newly planted trees and shrubs each spring and from time to time thereafter as needed.
- e. He shall inspect playground equipment regularly and see that it is safe and in proper condition to be safely used by the children. He shall be responsible for oiling, repairing, and properly maintaining the equipment.
- f. He shall inspect daily the playground surface and see that all injurious objects which might cause cuts, bruises, or other injuries are removed.
- g. He shall see that grass and weeds are properly removed along the edges of the walks or any crevice therein.
- h. When possible, he shall have all walks and steps free from ice or snow before school each morning. Mud, dust, and so forth shall be removed as necessary in order that the walks may be usable and presentable at all times.
- i. The custodian shall not permit any person or persons to loiter around the premises at any time.
- j. He shall supervise and be responsible for the cleanliness, sightliness, and orderliness of the grounds and premises belonging to the public school, and he shall see that the grounds are maintained at all times in a satisfactory condition for school use and occupancy.
